

As our agency's primary Civil deputy, I serve and execute all civil processes and orders throughout Washington County, including domestic abuse orders for protection, harassment restraining orders, orders for seizure, and writs of execution. I serve many different types of civil documents on behalf of individuals, private attorneys, the Court, and county or city departments and agencies, all of which have different rules regarding the timing and method of service.

In addition, I am responsible for executing all writs of recovery and evictions for the county, and processes involving the seizure of monies through bank levies, wage garnishment, and levies of personal and real property. The best part of my job is being able to provide services throughout all of Washington County, as my duties often having me going from one end of the county to the other every day.
