




MEET YOUR DEPUTIES

The Washington County Sheriff's Office serves a large geographical area, providing policing services to 23 communities. This includes the Village of Birchwood, which we've been proud to serve for many years. To make sure we consistently deliver high-quality patrol coverage, we have groups of deputies responsible for specific areas known as "contract deputies." The deputies who work in Birchwood have a site office in the Mahtomedi Public Works Building, where they begin and end their shift. This allows them to spend more time in the area, developing knowledge and relationships with people and businesses in their neighborhoods and getting to know what makes each community tick. Besides Birchwood, the Mahtomedi contract also includes Dellwood, Willernie, and Mahtomedi. We're pleased to introduce your deputies!
