<u>Proposal</u>: 18 feet for vehicle traffic and No center line. Drivers would be more defensive and drive slower. Drivers would be more willing to move around pedestrians. Want to make road usable for vehicles, walkers and bikers.

## Responses:

Tom S- hesitates to make drivers more defensive on road. Worried about people hitting

each other on road. Suggested moving centerline offset and create a master path on one side of road. We have noted reduced speeds noted from Sherriff am not ready to take any other action in the name of safety or reducing speeds. In fact feel we are at the point we should pause and declare victory, for bringing speeds down and increased safety for pedestrians, bikers and other drivers.

Gene- push out final decision until August to observe how everyone feels driving, walking and biking after chip sealing.

John A- Opposed to removing center or increasing width beyond existing blacktop, worried about reducing lane width, we are already at 9 feet, and if we narrow to 8 feet could create additional safety issues.

Tom P- should either take out center line, or set street width. Prefer having center line but would consider holding striping to 9 foot lanes. Also to continue the do not pass zone provided by the double yellow line, we would have to add more signage stating do not pass if center removed.

Ben motions to 9 foot lanes with double centerline, after centerline determined. Any extra width of road goes to pedestrian traffic. Tom P seconds, committee passes.
