New Business

- Four Sand barrels in place
 - Lakewood Lane- steep street with icing issues
 - Salt was approved for sand barrel at bottom of street
 - Birch snow removal, remove red flags?
 - City Manager will contact to confirm removal after season
- Lake Links
 - Present committee approves adoption of Lake Links
 - Ben will contact Lake Links director to ask about future granite path on 100' right of way on north side
- Two way radar speed sign -traffic data collection
 - Could be used as another measure to control speeds on Hall and count traffic
 - AC would likely be prefered over solar due to tree cover
 - Cost would be \$2000 plus AC hook-up
- Summer road work
 - Timetable for chip sealing
 - Schifsky cleans streets same time as Century College parking lots cleared
 - City maintenance worker finishes cleaning
 - Repair curbs and fill cracks
 - Chipseal (Pearson completed this last time)
 - Remove extra gravel/rocks
 - Striping or not striping of road Hall/Cedar discussed
 - Cedar/Hall is considered is a collector street
 - Look to get estimates for projects by April meeting
- Winter Road Repair
 - Large, immediate maintenance taken care of by city worker before contracting large scale projects
 - \circ $\;$ Schifsky will do large scale pothole and repair in April.
- Two Water Main break on Wildwood
 - \$1500 for cold repair, then need to repair again in April
 - Recommended to use temporary repair now
